INSTRUCTIONS: This permit does not release the permittee from complying with all the provisions of Section 307 of the International Fire Code 2021 Edition. Nor does it allow the permittee to act in any way to jeopardize life, safety, or endanger property. The permit is subject to review by the fire district and may be revoked at any time. I hereby indicate that I have read a copy of the districts requirements and agree to comply with all the sections of the requirement.

MATERIAL RESTRICTIONS: Open burning of rubbish containing paper products and household trash is prohibited.

LOCATION: Open Burning shall not be conducted within 50 feet of any structure or other combustible materials. Conditions that could cause the fire to spread to within 50 feet of a structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition. Fires in *approved* containers may be located no less than 15 feet from a structure.

TIME AND ATMOSPHERIC CONDITIONS: Open Burning shall only be performed when time and atmosphere conditions comply with the limits set forth in the open burning permit. Burning on Red Flag days, Fire Weather Watch days and during Stage 2 burn restrictions are strictly prohibited.

FIRE EXTINGUISHMENT EQUIPMENT: A garden hose shall be connected to a water supply, or other approved fire extinguishing equipment (5 pound, 4-A extinguisher) shall be readily available for use at the open burning site.

ATTENDANCE: Open Burning, bonfires, recreational fires, and use of portable outdoor fireplaces shall be constantly attended until the fire is extinguished.
